Our school uniform and the expectations

With the start of a new year, we thought we would send a helpful reminder of our school uniform expectations. We see school uniform as an essential part of school life. It is a symbol of belonging and something that unites all children at Haveley Hey Community School.

Winter uniform consists of...

- A purple jumper, cardigan, fleece
- Grey/black trousers, a grey/black skirt or pinafore
- A white polo shirt
- Black shoes/black trainers or black ankle boots

Spring/Summer uniform consists of... (the items listed above and/or:)

- Grey/black shorts (not cycling shorts)
- A purple gingham summer dress
- Black shoes/black trainers
- **Sandals without backs and Crocs are not to be worn in school**

PE kit...

- Black tracksuit bottoms
- A white polo shirt or white round neck t-shirt
- Black shorts
- Black pumps or black trainers

Hair, make-up and piercings...

- Make up, including nail polish/nail extensions, should not be worn
- Pupils who have pierced ears may wear discreet studs. These must be removed during PE lessons for safety reasons
- Jewellery is not part of our school uniform and therefore should not be worn
- Extremes in hairstyle are to be avoided. Hair should not be dyed any non-natural colour, i.e. pink, blue, green etc.

If any parents or carers struggle to get a full set of uniform for their child/ren, please let school know and we will try our best to support.
