IMPORTANT REMINDER – Nut Products in School



Nut based products: We have a number of children in school who are severely allergic to all types of nut. We ask that parents do not send nuts or nut-based products to school for snacks, lunches or birthday treats. This includes chocolate nut spreads. This helps us to reduce the risk of contact for these children.

With regard to Birthday treats, we ask that all parents follow the guidelines below.

Birthday sweets/treats:

- must not contain nuts or be made in a factory with nuts
 - must be unopened in their original packaging
 - packaging must display the full list of ingredients
- must be dropped off at the school office before going down to class
